**One:** "Power is not only what you have, but what an opponent thinks you have. If your organization is small, hide your numbers in the dark and raise a din that will make everyone think you have many more people than

you do."

**Two:** "Never go outside the experience of your people. When an action or tactic is outside the experience of the people, the result is confusion, fear and retreat... [and] the collapse of communication."

**Three:** "Whenever possible, go outside

the expertise of the enemy. Look for ways to increase insecurity, anxiety and uncertainty (This happens all the time. Watch how many organizations under attack are blind-sided by seemingly irrelevant arguments that they are then forced to address.)"

**Four:** "Make the enemy

live up to its own book of rules. You can kill them with this, for they can no more obey their own rules than the Christian church can live up to Christianity."
